## Privacy policy

The following privacy policy informs you about the most important aspects of data processing on our website.

Personal data is collected and processed only on the basis of the legal provisions (General Data Protection Regulation, Telecommunications Act 2003).

As soon as you access or visit this website as a user, your IP address, the start and end of the session are recorded. This is due to technical reasons and therefore constitutes a legitimate interest within the meaning of Article 6 (1) (f) GDPR.

#### **Contact Us**

If you contact us, either via our contact form on our website, or by email, the data you transmit to us will be stored by us for six months in order to process your enquiry or in the event of further follow-up questions. There will be no disclosure of your transmitted data without your consent.

#### Cookies

Our website uses so-called cookies. These are small text files that are stored on your device with the help of the browser. They do not cause any harm. We use cookies to make our offer user-friendly. Some cookies remain stored on your device until you delete them. They allow us to recognize your browser the next time you visit. If you do not want this, you can set up your browser so that it informs you about the setting of cookies and you only allow this in individual cases. If you disable cookies, the functionality of our website may be limited.

### **Google Analytics**

We use Google Analytics to analyze the access to our website.

The Google Analytics cookie stores which pages you visit, how you got to them and some basic information about your computer. All this information is anonymous. We don't know who you are, only that someone has visited our website.

# Your rights as a data subject
